
- **Residential**

- Daniels Forest Final Plat Administratively approved and scheduled for Public Hearing on 11/4/2024.








Water & Sewer Impact Fees



Monthly Financial Report thru September 2024

- Sales Tax Revenues continue to be relatively flat
- Stage 2 water restrictions in effect (with Stage 3 already under consideration) targeting residential users - revenue impact expected to be significant given large residential base
- Hotel-Motel Revenues lower following Quality Inn refund in 2022-2023
- 12th Month in Fiscal Year 2023-2024 or 100% complete
- Revenues and Expenses/Expenditures are unaudited

Extra friendly, welcomed us to Texas. Discussed how he use to live near our neighborhood. Smiled, and was VERY polite.


The officer was professional and very respectful. My hats off to him and your department.




Monthly Utility Connections



Monthly Utility Consumption





Annual Customer Water Usage



September 2024 Rainfall






Influent: Wastewater or other liquid flowing into a reservoir, basin, or treatment plant.


Effluent: Wastewater or other liquid, partially or completely treated, flowing from a reservoir, basin, treatment process, or treatment plant.

Annual Effluent




